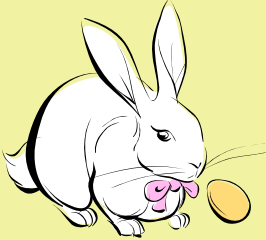

We **WILL** be monitoring and enforcing this strictly as we strive to have an attractive and appealing neighborhood. **Please** let us know if you mow grass or need to hire someone. - ◆ **Animals**— All dogs need to be on a leash when taken outside of your property. Remember to “Scoop the Poop” on your personal property as well as along the parkway, walking trails and throughout the neighborhood **PLEASE!!!!** Do **NOT** allow your pets to enter onto other residents’ property. Cats do NOT have a “leash” law; however, keep up with your cat(s) and be considerate of other residents that may not want your animal on their property.

- ◆ **Tennis Courts**—The wind screen around the tennis courts will be replaced in the near future. A few other minor repairs will also be made to the courts.

- ⇒ **Pool Passes:** The number of members in your household is taken from our current records in the HOA office. If you need to have your pool pass changed, there will be \$3.00 charge to receive a new one. Without a pass you will **NOT** be allowed to enter the pool.
- ⇒ **Pool Parties:** All Parties **must** be scheduled 48 hours in advance. **All** parties will be charged \$20 per hour for the use of the pool. Any party scheduled that isn't cancelled **24 hours** prior will be charged for the party. Please contact Karen @ 358-0299 ext: 201 or kboswell@starmount.com for information and availability.
- ⇒ **Pool Rules:** These will be in the packet along with your pool pass that will be mailed out the middle of May, 2010. Please review carefully
- ⇒ **Guests:** You are allowed 4 guest per pool pass, kids under 18 without their parents are allowed up to 2 guests. Having more than 4 guests would be considered a party and must be arranged in advance. Residents **MUST** accompany their guests to the pool and stay with them at all times.
- ⇒ **Pool Entry:** No one is allowed to enter the pool when it is not open with lifeguards present!! This includes the Kidde Pool. Parents, PLEASE talk with your children about not entering the pool after hours. IT IS VERY DANGEROUS—KNOW WHERE YOUR KIDS ARE. Anyone caught entering the pool when it is closed **WILL** have their pool privileges cancelled. Since there is only one pass per family, the entire household loses their privileges as well. If you see someone in the pool after-hours, please call the police immediately. They **ARE** trespassing.
- ⇒ **Lifeguards:** Please respect their authority as they work hard to keep everyone safe. Not doing so can result in a suspension of pool privileges.
- ⇒ **Vandalism:** If you witness anyone destroying property or entering the pool after hours, please call the police. Vandalism can be extremely costly to the Association.
- ⇒ **Children:** A major concern we have had in the past is unsupervised children while at the pool. Parents, please keep in mind the extreme danger of kids not properly monitored at the pool. Also, be very careful of sending older siblings to be their caretaker, as there have been some serious issues when this occurs.
- ⇒ **Hours:** Please remember that during School hours the pool will NOT be open. While school is in session the pool will open Monday—Friday 4:30—8:00pm starting May 29th, 2010. Once schools out the hours will change to 10am—8pm daily.
- ⇒ **Floats**—Please remember during the times the pool is crowded, floats will not be allowed in the pool. We leave this decision of when and what types of floats are acceptable to the lifeguards. If children can't be seen or can simply fall through the bottom of the float, they certainly will NOT be allowed in the pool.
- ⇒ **Maintenance-** Painting and other minor repairs will be completed prior to the opening of the pool.

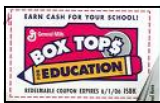

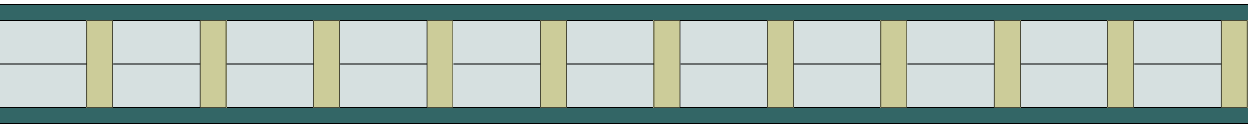
